## Instructions for Preparation

Dear Client:

### FLEAS

Remove all articles from the floor areas. Thoroughly vacuum carpeting, remove vacuum bag immediately. Clean all bed clothing when treatment is completed. If you have a pet, please have it washed and defleaed the same day.

### COCKROACHES

Remove articles from kitchen and bathroom cabinets, including countertops, drawers, Shelf paper if it is possible. Place all these articles in large plastic contractors bags and place them preferably in middle of living room. Upon your return wash all countertops with a solution of soap and water. Install new shelf paper, (**do not wash off the shelves**). Clean-up all dead cockroaches and flush them down the toilet.

### GRAIN PESTS

Repeat procedure for cockroaches. Remove all suspect packages, even foodstuffs that are not opened, discard all infested and suspect packages.

### ANTS

Please remove all articles from infested or suspect from closets, cabinets, drawers, etc.

We will be using all E.P.A. approved materials and according to the manufacturers label. There may be some activity possibly up to three weeks upon completion of treatment, this is expected, due to the life cycle of the insect. If the problem continues, please notify **Berry's Pest Control** for further help in this matter.

We request that your property be unoccupied (**pets also included**) for at least a period of **(3) three hours** after treatment for the problem. It is mandatory , unless other arrangements have been made.
